Amidst the global pandemic, Fort McMurray experienced disastrous flooding which further impacted work, businesses, and disrupted the lives of thousands of people. Colin took it upon himself to get things rolling on the Food Bank drive initiative for the Wood Buffalo Region through both tangible and monetary donations. Contactless drop-offs were set-up on site, and donations were made directly to the Food Bank. The two rallied colleagues to support their community, volunteer their time to run a food drive, organize a raffle ticket draw and collect donations.

In addition, Ledcor also donated \$25,000 to the Wood Buffalo Food Bank and various project teams in the Edmonton area also reached out locally to help. In total, more than \$50,000 was

raised for the Wood Buffalo Food Bank, as a result of Colin and Ben's efforts.

Last September, Colin also organized a team to represent Ledcor in the Northern Lights Health Foundations' third annual Hospital Bed Races. Colin and Ben's team pushed a hospital bed bearing a 150-lb weight in a bobsled-style race. All of the proceeds, totaling \$56,000, supported healthcare in the Wood Buffalo Region.
