

Waiward began its competency management system journey toward MODOS in 2012. <u>No</u> other major change was made.

- "According to Alberta's Occupational Health and Safety figures, in 2012, Waiward had 28 disabling injuries and six lost time claims during 732,556 hours covered by WCB. That's an average of one lost time claim for every 122,000 hours worked."
- "As of April 2017, Waiward has accumulated more than 4.66 million hours free of lost time incidents"
- "That is an 800 per cent improvement over historical averages (and a 3,700 per cent improvement over 2012)."
